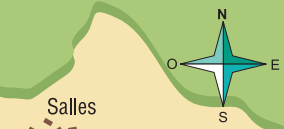


# Rambling in Lot-et-Garonne

# Walking in the Lot-et-Garonne

Trentels – Communauté de Communes Fumélois - Lémance



You are going to cover : 6.7 km. You should allow : 1 ¾ hrs on foot.

You are 15 km east of Villeneuve-sur-Lot on the D 911.

Park in the Place close to the Town Hall. Set off from here.

Take with you a water bottle and binoculars.

The markings are yellow. Difficulty : easy. Overall change in altitude: 215 m.

## A walk on the Trentels hillside

*The best way to appreciate the rugged landscape of the Lot and to find its hidden treasures is to climb to high ground. Walled houses, pigeon towers, orchards, wooded summits...*

- 1 Go down on the D 911 and follow it to the left, in front of the town-hall. Take the road in the same direction towards the church and the Château de la Chapelle Trentels.
- 2 Go along the wall of the cemetery and then towards Cassé Gros and Tambour. At the first crossroads, after an orchard, continue towards Chamouleau.
- 3 On the bend, follow the tarmac path to the right. Go to the right of the Maison de Tambour and continue on a pebble track. Go straight ahead on a dirt track that slopes gently downwards. Go between a wooded bank and a plum orchard. Follow the tarmac path straight on.
- 4 At the sign to Capellet, follow the road to the left which crosses the hamlets of Mont Lafage, Lafage, Lafage Haute and then Lagamote. At the crossroads in Couleau, go left, towards Broutou and Mérice. At the next junction, take the asphalt path to the left, which becomes a chalk path.
- 5 At the first bend, fork to the right on a shaded path, above a plum orchard. Further on, pass between two rows of trees, then between a wood and an orchard. Go up the panoramic road to the left. At La Croix de Balen and Lastailades, continue on the descending road.
- 6 At Fon de Pèbre, go up on the other side on a chalk track. Keep going straight on under a hedge, then below a wood.
- 7 Go back down the winding road of the outward journey, to the church.
- 2 Cross the car park, diagonally to the right and take the small road, bordered by an orchard, to the left. Return to the town hall square by the community hall car park.

### The Trentels hillside

*This has been described as "a walk on the Trentels hillside" because it simply consists of a circuit of this hill that stands beside the Lot. It is not possible to climb to the top because it is private land; and the densely wooded slopes do not allow any panoramic views of the valley below. However, there are some views of the valley and, from the other side, of the Haut-Agenais countryside, towards the bottom of the hill. Walkers will also see lots of orchards, a few pastures where the Blondes d'Aquitaine graze, and some traditional farm buildings. The route is fairly easy and at seven kilometres is suitable for a family walk.*
